The verification is via email and takes less than five minutes. Families sign off on the application to allow you to share this information with our Camp Director.
3. Contact our office for more postcards, questions about our program, or other information needed.
4. We offer transportation assistance and are available for 1:1 calls with families who may want more information about Camp.
