- 2. If a student applies to Camp, they will need an educator to verify the disability for us. Please ensure families have your correct email for an online application. The verification is via email and takes less than five minutes. Families sign off on the application to allow you to share this information with our Camp Director.**
- 3. Contact our office for more postcards, questions about our Camp program, or other information needed.**
- 4. We offer transportation assistance and can schedule 1:1 calls with families who may want more information about Camp.**
